#### A report from our Membership Chairperson, Cinda Dawson

As of December 15, 2021 our membership is 155 people, 4 of whom are under 18. At the beginning of the year we had 90. These totals are down from past years. At the end of 2019, we had 293 members and at the end of 2018, we had 266 members.

During Covid we did not accept new members but established a "waiting list" of people interested in joining LGMS. This fall we brought in about 15 new members from the waiting list of 48 people. However, not everyone on the list responded when we reached out. We plan on training more new members in January and February, adding about 8 per month. At that rate we expect that it will take until March to get to everyone on the list.

Experienced members are reminded to welcome newcomers and politely help them with machines and clean up procedures.

#### **Facebook**

Our private Facebook group had 105 members before the pandemic. After removing people who did not renew their membership in early spring, we went down to 80.

Happily, we are back up to 94 now; however, only 46 people view posts regularly. Marianna Ziegler does a great job of inviting new members once a month via email.

Our public page has 641 members! We gained over 100 this year! A reminder: if you post something that is meant for all to see, post to the public page first, then share it to the private page. You cannot easily do it in reverse. Events and garage sales are only posted to the private group.
